#### **MINUTES:**

Chairperson Panzenbeck made a motion to adopt the minutes of the IDA/LEAC meeting held on February 25, 2025 and asked for a second. The motion was seconded by Lisa Travatello. Motion carried as follows:

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Chairperson Panzenbeck announced that there are two Unfinished Business matters this evening:

- 115 Glen Street Property Owner, LLC
- Glen Cove Villas Forbearance

Glen Cove Villas: Mr. Tyler and Ms. Fangmann provided the members with the latest update, including satisfaction of the mechanics lien which has been paid and status of securing a land/bridge loan, which closed. Georgica Green Ventures executed a development advisory agreement with the owner of the Villas. However, Mr. Tyler reminded the board that a formal default letter was sent to Glen Cove Villas on 2/14/25 giving them 30 days to remedy all items outlined in the forbearance agreement and since all items were not fully satisfied, the approval would be terminated by 3/17/25. Mr. Tyler informed the applicant that if they fail to satisfy the stipulations outlined in the default letter by the end date of 3/17/25, the straight lease would be terminated, but the applicant would be free to reapply for financial assistance to the IDA in the future.

115 Glen Street Property Owner, LLC: Mr. Dan Deegan, legal counsel for 115 Glen St Property Owner LLC and the applicant, Alec Ornstein were in attendance at the meeting. Mr. Tyler reminded the board that this special meeting was being held at the applicant and board's request to give the board time to evaluate the information presented to them during and after the 2/25/25 meeting and at the applicant's request for the board to make a decision on their application for financial assistance.

Both the applicant and their legal counsel expressed disappointment with this decision and repeated that the project is not viable without a PILOT. They respectfully requested whether the board would be open to a restructured PILOT. The board suggested that the applicant put together a shortened PILOT request and come back to the board with that information for further consideration.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Tyler and Ms. Fangmann recommended that discussion on Garvies Block F Request for IDA Consent be tabled as they are awaiting further information from the applicant.
